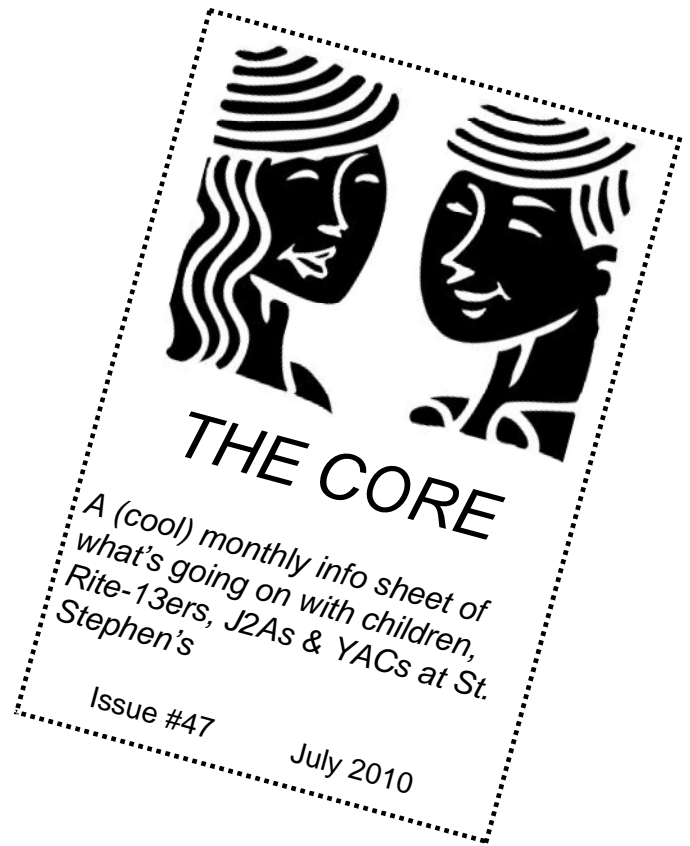
Camp Compassion
